LIFEGUARDS

(Part Time & Full Time Positions)

- ***Includes available hours beginning June 19. ****
- Lifeguard Training (including First Aid) **
- Yearly CPR certification required (**).
- American Red Cross Waterfront Module**
- Other qualifications and experience considered.
- From mid-June thru Labor Day
- Water & beach supervision including safety, first aid, water rescue & enforcement of rules.
- Report problems & disciplinary incidents to Supervisor.
- Check AED, first aid kit, rescue equipment and recreational equipment before opening beach. Restock as necessary.
- Attend drills which will be held weekly.
- Maintain current certification throughout employment period. Failure to do so will result in termination.
- Remain on the beach to perform duties until relieved by another Lifeguard.
- Cover special events.
- Complete daily reports equipment, 1st aid kit, beach conditions, etc.
- Responsible for Club-provided lifeguard attire.

Hourly salary positions commensurate with experience (i.e., 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc. year guard).

BEACH PATROL/ BEACH OPENING

- ***Includes available hours beginning June 19. ****
- Mature young Adult or older.
- From mid-June thru Labor Day
- Rotational hours/days
- Get the beaches ready for daily use during 1st shift on assigned days. Rake and clean up debris and toys on the beach.
- Ensure entrance to Clubhouse Beach via valid badge (i.e., CLCC members & guests); ensure that those persons in or about the Clubhouse display a current badge.
- Ensure entrance to Rose Beach via valid badge (i.e., CLCC members & guests)
- Coverage during normal beach operational hours including major Club activities

SECURITY

- Adult preferred or mature youngadult with access to a boat.
- General Security coverage & badge checking (beaches, docks, floats, etc.)

CLUBMASTER(S)

- Full-time and possible multiple part time (or fill-in) positions.
- Need coverage at designated times for when Club is open.
- Club Hours: 7 days per week with times dependent upon Clubhouse activities schedule
- Oversee use of the Clubhouse; oversee ongoing & ad-hoc activities
- Facilitate Club activity equipment borrowing (games, basketballs, etc.).
- Responsible for Clubhouse: interior cleaning of Clubhouse, porch, yard, and steps of Clubhouse, including side basketball courts.
- On a daily basis, empty trash cans that are on the beach, bridge, inside the Clubhouse and porch; clean up property on the outside of the fence in the parking & dumpster area
- Sweep/mop floors daily during the morning AND afternoon shifts
- Clean women's and men's restrooms daily
- Ensure that those persons in or about the Clubhouse display a current badge.
- Set up for Club functions under the direction of the function's chairperson
- Not have any other person substitute as Club Manager without approval of the President and/or Governor in charge of the Clubhouse.
- Oversee the CLCC "lost & found" program

Hourly salary position commensurate with experience & planned hours.

Hours based upon planned Clubhouse coverage.

WSI/SWIM INSTRUCTOR WSI required (**).

- Organization & operation of the swimming program.
- Collect registration fees & supply financial report by end of 1st week of lessons.
- Get scheduling concurrence from Governor in charge of water safety.
- Turn in results of participant testing & records/log (level info) at season's end
- Hours per week based on class demand. Classes to start approx. first week of July through mid-August with registration late June and at Open House.
- Offer lessons at all levels of the American Red Cross Swimming Instruction Program, even if registrants re few.

Hourly salary position commensurate with experience.

ASS'T SWIM INSTRUCTOR (Aide)

- Assist the Swim Instructor.
- Ability to work with children and help WSI with teaching and phone chains when communication with students is needed.
- Hours dependent upon need & Hiring Committee approval.

- Verify that all applicants are members in good standing (badge numbers).
- Collect registration fees not collected through club's mail registration program & submit fees and report to CLCC Treasurer by second day after first NJRLL meet.
- Post Championship entries 48 hours prior to NJRLL's closing deadline.
